(College transcript information may not be needed for this scholarship if the criteria shows that this scholarship is for high school seniors only. Check the criteria!)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS:

1. **No application will be considered if it is not received before the deadline, if all information requested is not included and if it does not conform to the following requirements.**
2. Please be sure that your application conforms to the following:
 - a. Single-sided only; if any paperwork is double-sided you **must** copy it to ensure that all submissions to CBF are single-sided;
 - b. NO staples, do not staple the application or any of the paperwork attached to the application;
 - c. NO folders or covers whatsoever;
 - d. NO social security numbers on any paperwork whatsoever, and.;
 - e. If a resume is requested with a specific scholarship, please be sure that you do not list your social security number on the resume.
3. If applicant is a high school senior Columbia Basin Foundation must receive an official high school transcript.
4. If applicant is a current college student Columbia Basin Foundation must receive an official college transcript.
5. If applicant is a college graduate Columbia Basin Foundation must receive the final official college transcript.
6. All completed applications will be considered in conformance with equal opportunity standards.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT – CHECKLIST:

1. **Complete the application online, print and mail it along with the necessary required items before the deadline to: Columbia Basin Foundation, 234 First Avenue NW, Suite B, Ephrata, WA 98823.**
2. If you are a high school senior, attach an official high school transcript.
3. If you are a current college student or a college graduate returning to college, attach an up-to-date official college transcript.
4. Attach two letters of recommendation. One letter of recommendation should be from a teacher or counselor at your high school, or college if you have already graduated from high school. Additional letter of recommendation should be from someone who is not related and is not connected with the high school or college, if applicable.
